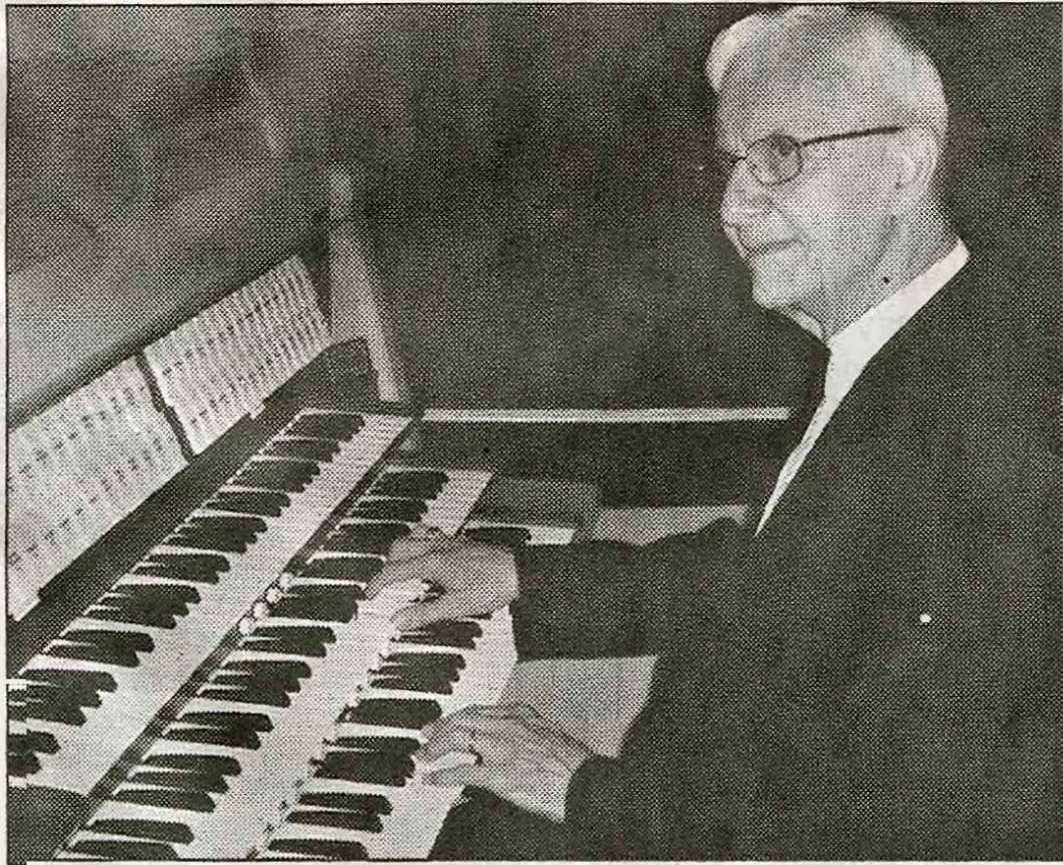

Preuss releases CD

RACINE — Arthur Preuss Sr., organist at St. John's Lutheran Church, 1501 Erie St., has made a compact disc by recording 31 of his original organ compositions at the request of his family and members of the congregation. Preuss's pieces were played by him on the 52-rank Schlicker organ in the sanctuary at St. John's, where he has been organist and director of music since 1957. Many of the originals are based on familiar

hymn tunes. Three pieces include trumpeters Diane Andersen and Leif Lovdahl.
